## History

- ❖ November 11, 1899, 34 ladies of "good character" met and formed the Afternoon Auxiliary.
- ❖ 2003 Purchased Thrift Seller building.
- ❖ In 2010 the RIH Volunteer Services Coordinator assumed many of the service programs we were overseeing.

## Accomplishments

- ❖ Since 1990, approximately 2 million has been raised to purchase special equipment such as, Pulmonary Function System, Instrument Tables, Breast Feeding Pumps, Stretchers, ECG Carts, Birthing Beds and Cancer, ICU Renovations.
